- © Strainer designed to prevent tea leaves from causing clogs.

**Advantages  
of  
this strainer  
design**

Tea leaves circulate freely.

→ **More even steeping for better flavor.**

The gap between the strainer and the spout helps prevent tea leaf clogs.

→ **Tea pours easily!**

- © Comfortable Handle Length

- © Anti-drip spout

- © Comfortably distributed weight for ease of use  
Large: approx. 330g    Small: approx. 280g

## Maintenance:

- 1 .It is ordinarily enough to simply rinse and turn over to air-dry.**

→It can also be better to wipe dry with a soft cloth.

- 2 .If you begin to notice off smells, let sit in direct sunlight for a day to dry.**

→CAUTION: Do not use chlorine bleach, because it will soak into the ceramic.



- 3 .If you feel the need to sterilize your teapot, you can do so by placing it in boiling water.**

→Once the water reaches a boil, let sit for about 3 minutes.
